The NSS/DLLE Department of Arts, Commerce, and Science College, Kharepatan, organized a blood donation drive recently, fostering a culture of altruism and community service.

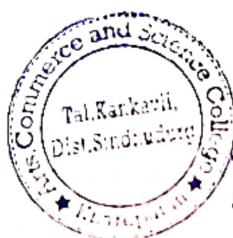
