

Blood Donation Camp Report

On 22nd July 2021, a Blood Donation Camp was successfully organized in collaboration with the NSS/ DLLE Department of this college and Lokmat - Sindhudurg. The camp was inaugurated by the esteemed Principal Prof. Dr. Atmaram Kamble, in the presence of several eminent personalities from the village and the hospital community.

The inauguration ceremony was marked by encouraging speeches from Principal Prof. Dr. Atmaram Kamble and the medical officers from SSPM Medical College and Lifetime Hospital Blood Bank, Kudal, Sindhudurg. They expressed their gratitude and extended best wishes to all the donors, emphasizing the critical importance of blood donation in saving lives.

The camp saw a commendable turnout from eligible students and villagers, who participated enthusiastically. Prior to donating blood, participants underwent a series of health checks to ensure their eligibility. A total of 33 individuals received comprehensive health check-ups, 42 had their haemoglobin levels checked, and 38 had their blood groups determined. Despite the rigorous screening process, 19 units of blood were successfully collected during the camp. This valuable contribution will support the local blood bank and assist in medical emergencies within the community.

Post-donation, all participants were provided with refreshments to help them recover and replenish their energy levels. The event was not only a step towards promoting health and community service but also fostered a sense of unity and responsibility among the students and local residents.

The NSS/DLLE Department of ACS College Kharepatan and Lokmat - Sindhudurg extend their heartfelt thanks to all the volunteers, donors, and medical staff who made this event a success. Their collective efforts have contributed significantly to the well-being of the community.
